An opportunity has arisen within our Stickney Church of England School and New Leake School federation to appoint an enthusiastic and flexible 1:1 Teaching Assistant, who is hardworking and energetic, and who has a positive attitude, good sense of humour and is fun to work with. The post is to work with primarily a KS1 child with additional needs and will be based at our New Leake Primary School although may occasionally be asked to work across the federation.

Our schools are small, friendly and successful village schools with an excellent ethos for learning. You will join a successful, supportive and friendly team of professionals who all achieve high standards in academic and personal development and where the children are happy, well-motivated and enthusiastic learners. Applicants will require a relevant NVQ 2 or equivalent, experience of working with SEND children and recent primary school-based experience of supporting children within this age group. As well as supporting academic learning, the role will involve nurturing the social and behavioural development of the children.

Duties include:

- Act in accordance with school policies and procedures and relevant legislation, particularly in relation to child protection and behaviour management.
- Have excellent communication, interpersonal and organisational skills.
- Have high expectations of all pupils and strong behaviour management skills
- Participate in the preparation of the indoor and outdoor learning environments
